Brahmodaya 2006 Invitation & Guidelines

General:

- Contributions from WBF members are invited for Brahmodaya'06, the convention souvenir magazine, which will be issued at the Convention'06. Contributions can be in the form of essays, biographies, short stories, poetry, photographs, or any literary form.
- Contributions should be consistent with the theme of the convention which is "Sanatana Dharma in the New Millennium." However, contributions on contemporary nonpolitical issues of direct concern to our community such as analysis and preservation of our heritage and culture along with a strong appreciation of modern science and technology, education, and careers are also welcome.
- Contributions which inspire and educate our younger generation are particularly welcome. Youth and children are specially invited to write on any topic of interest to our community.
- The articles must be submitted electronically and sent by e-mail as an attachment. A document must be either a plain text file or a Microsoft Word file with minimal formatting and absolutely no macros. A file containing active macros will not be opened by our software. Please use Ariel or Times New Roman font size 12. Please avoid any fancy lettering, word art, bold, or italicized fonts. Use italicized fonts only when you quote a foreign language text in Roman. All contributions must be concise and limited to about 2000 words. All the photographs and drawings must be in jpg or tif format with high enough resolution for printing. In addition to the electronic version of a photograph, please also send a hard copy by ordinary mail.
- Please send your brief introduction, school grade and age if under 18, and contact information limited to 4-5 lines and your passport size photograph for publication.
- It is assumed that the sender has the copyright and the legal authority for the publication of the contributed material. Contributions from minors must be accompanied by a letter from their guardian authenticating the contribution, and authorizing us to publish the material.

Poster Session for children:

- The topic for the poster session is Brahmans in search of Truth. Search for Truth is search for God. In this context you can include biographies of famous saints, scientists, mathematicians or any one who, in your opinion, spent his/her life searching for Truth. All children who submit a poster for this session will be recognized at the convention.
